Individualized Attention

- Viterbo University offers a faculty to student ratio of 1:11 with class sizes averaging 16 and lab sizes averaging 13. No classes are taught by teacher assistants or graduate students.

Estimated Costs Per Year

Scholarships

First-year undergraduates may qualify for academic scholarships up to \$14,000 per year based upon their secondary GPA. Transfer undergraduate students may receive academic scholarships up to \$8,000 per year. There may also be opportunities for athletic and/or talent scholarships offered by the athletics department or the College of Arts and Letters.

Requirements

- TOEFL = 61 IBT or IELTS 5.5 (undergraduate); 79 IBT or IELTS 6.5 (graduate)*
- GPA (grade point average)
 - First-year undergraduate = minimum 2.5
 - Transfer undergraduate = minimum 2.0
 - Graduate = Admission decisions made by academic departments

*Conditional admission available for most academic programs through VESL.
