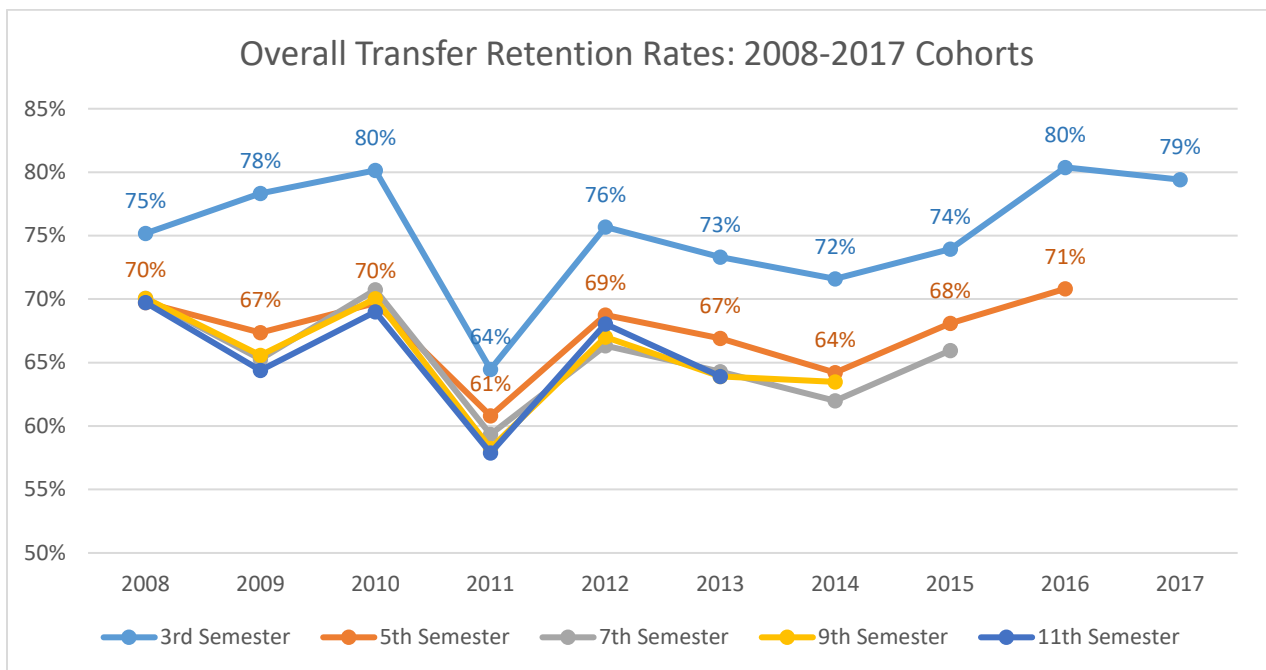


## Viterbo University Transfer Retention Rate Dashboard: Fall 2018

The retention rates below are based on the degree-seeking undergraduate students who entered Viterbo University as transfer students in the fall term. In alignment with the National Center for Education Statistics, exclusions from the groups are allowed for military activations or deployments, deaths, and permanent disabilities. The retention rate for a given time interval is computed by dividing the number of students from the originally enrolled group who were registered or graduated after that given time interval by the number in the group when originally enrolled, taking into account exclusions at that time. The retention rate for the Fall 2016 cohort is the percentage of the transfer students who entered Viterbo in Fall 2016 and were enrolled at Viterbo at census date of Fall 2017.

## Viterbo University Graduation Rate Dashboard: Fall 2018

The graduation rates below are based on the degree-seeking undergraduate students who entered Viterbo University as transfer students. Exclusions from the cohort groups are allowed for military activations or deployments, deaths, and permanent disabilities. The four-year graduation rate of 60% for the Fall 2012 transfer cohort is the percentage of the transfer students who entered Viterbo in Fall 2012 and graduated from Viterbo by the end of Summer 2016.
