

Student Outcome Data: Master of Arts in Education (Wisconsin)

Graduation Rates:

For students who progress at a full-time status, the expected time to completion Master of Arts in Education program in Wisconsin is 6 terms. The 6-term completion rate for students who start in fall is 71%, in spring is 56%, and in summer is 38%. Because almost all students in the MAE program are working fulltime as teachers or administrators, and because the core sequence of courses includes development of an action research project, it is not uncommon for a student to take a semester off or progress at a slower rate to balance the demands of their professional and personal lives.
